Grand Marshal Matt Nichols



Matt Nichols was born to Frank and Peggy Nichols in Hood River, Oregon on May 7, 1947. He is the middle child of 11 children, so you can imagine what a busy house he was born into. The family may have been poor financially, but that never slowed the Nichols family down. There was always lots of exciting activities, and the family learned to have fun with very little. That's where many of the neighborhood kids liked to hang out!

Being the oldest of the second half of his siblings, Matt established himself as their leader. There were many activities such as an overnight camping trip with all the siblings, from Matt at age 11, down to the youngest at age 3. This was a camping trip, of just the kids, no parents or older kids participated, (except for one check-in by an older brother) but they did have their protective black lab, Shadow, along for the journey. Shadow did help them all find their way back home, in the dark, after getting too scared to actually spend the night! My how times have changed.

Matt lived in Hood River, until the age of 15, when he and the youngest 7 children relocated with their parents to Seattle, Washington. His mother's brother, Donald Cameron, lived on Cameron Rd. in Freeland, and the family soon found itself relocating to Whidbey Island in 1964.

Frank Nichols had been a boat builder and designer in Hood River and brought those skills along with him to start up a small boatyard in an abandoned machine shop in Freeland. Naturally, all of Franks children were the first crewmembers, so everyone got experience at the many aspects of boatbuilding, and at a very young age.

Matt commercial fished in Prince William sound, Alaska, during the summers of his high school years. The small boatyard was still struggling to get established, and, at times, some of the money Matt made commercial fishing, went to help keep the small boatyard afloat. Matt graduated from Langley High School in 1965.

In 1966, Matt joined the Airforce and travelled much of Europe working as a weapons mechanic. He spent his last year stationed in Bangor, Maine, where he met Cassie, his soon "wife to be". They married in 1970 in Freeland and have made WA and Whidbey Island their home for 52 years. There they raised 5 children, while also helping take in 5 other teens over the years and helping a refugee family from Laos get established. Today, they tremendously enjoy their family, and 11 grandchildren and 4 great grandchildren, and extended family!

Over the years, Matt rose to be become the President of what became known as Nichols Brothers Boat Builders (now in business 58 years). From the early days of building fishing boats up until the early 1980s, and then on to making their mark in building specialized high-speed aluminum catamarans, along with a huge myriad of other commercial vessel types, including tugs, barges, landing craft, overnight cruise vessels, military vessels and more. Matt along with his brother Archie, led this company into nationwide, and even a level of international, recognition in the industry. He was voted the Marine W.I.A.R Citizen of the Year in 2004.

God and family have been Matt's priorities throughout his adult years. Matt has been established and serving at his church in various capacities, for many years, and finds great joy in so doing. Outside of the busy-ness of running a very demanding company, Matt's focus was always on having fun with the family, all the while teaching them to be hard-working contributors to society.

He is still working at Nichols Brothers at 75 years old and helping to ensure that so many families can keep working and putting food on the table. He has always loved the Marine Industry, the great friends he's made, his awesome talented crew and he's always excited to put together the next new project.

Whatever Matt has done in life, he's committed to with full vigor, giving it everything he's got. He's been known to be extremely competitive in, as well as devoted to, everything he has an interest in; known to laugh, appreciate and tell "a good story" (and there are many!) and known to enjoy and appreciate hard work and the blessings of, life, family, and friends.

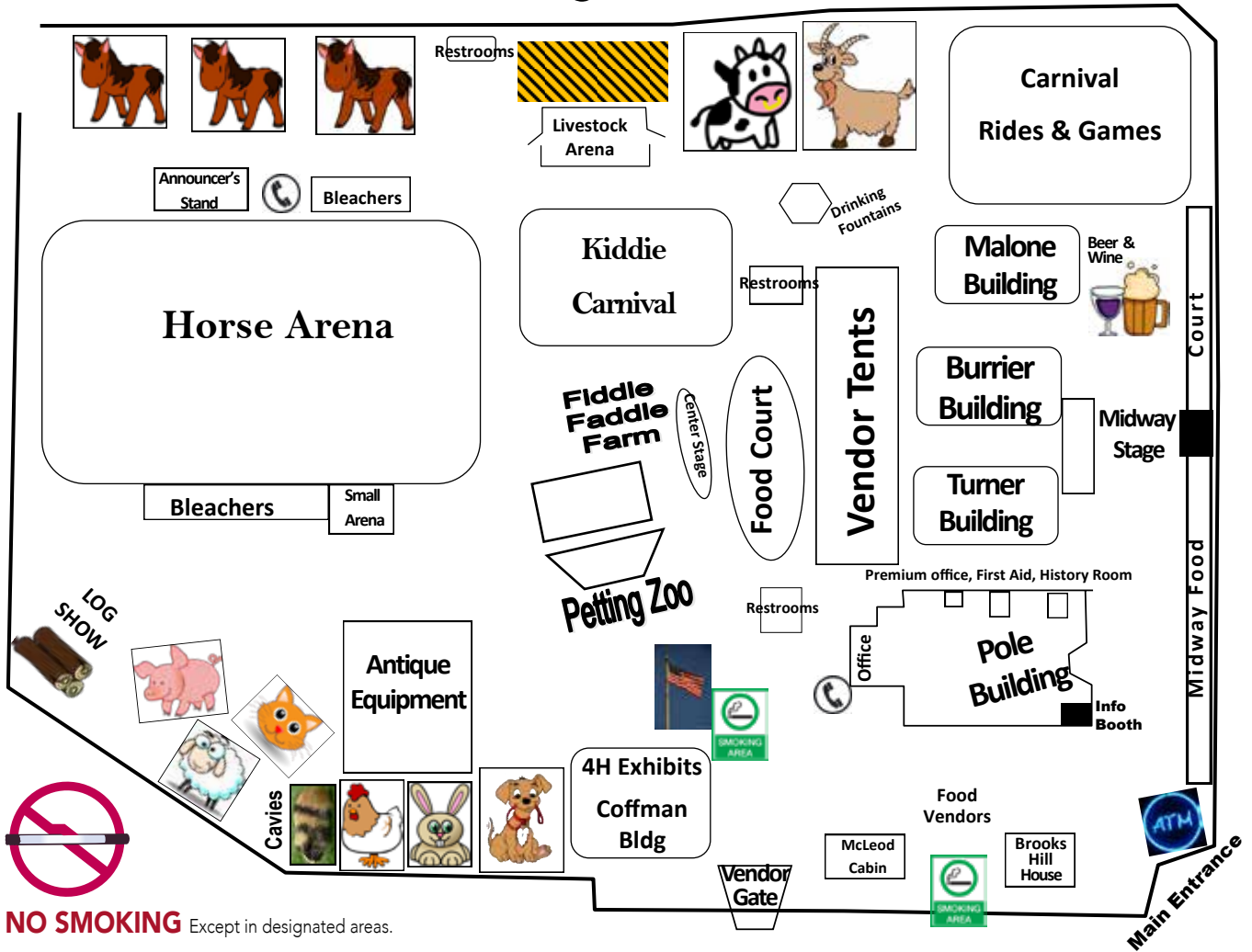

West Coast Country Heat

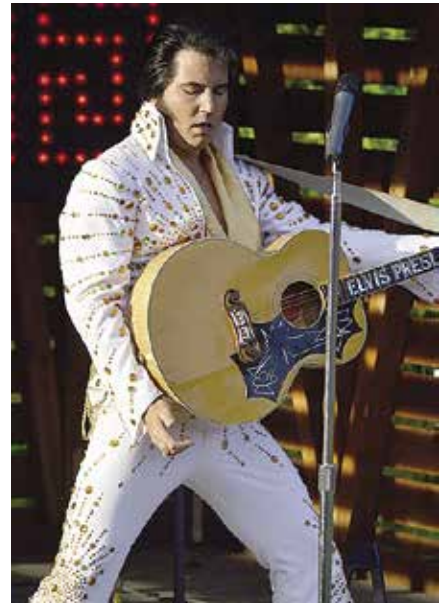
